CAMPUS VEST

The Campus Vest is a cardigan vest that's perfectly preppy for layering. This pattern comes in two views, with a cropped, straight body or with a hip length body with gentle A-line shaping to accommodate hips.

Knit it your way for what you need in your wardrobe. Perfectly proportioned for any outfit, this is a truly versatile staple that you'll reach for over and over again. This classic piece knits up in a variety of fabrics and is shown here in both woolen spun and worsted spun yarns for a different effect on each.

Size Selection

Sizes A (B, C, D) (E, F, G) (H, I, J) to fit **upper bust measurements** of 31 (34.25, 37.5, 40.75) (44, 47.25, 50.5) (53.75, 57, 60.25)" / 78.5 (87, 95.5, 103.5) (112, 120, 128.5) (136.5, 145, 153) cm.

Select a size based on the upper bust measurement, but it is also graded for full bust measurements of 30 (34, 38, 42) (46, 50, 54) (58, 62, 66)" / 76 (86.5, 96.5, 106.5) (117, 127, 137) (147.5, 157.5, 167.5) cm.

The garment measures 32.25 (36.25, 40.25, 44.25) (48.25, 52.25, 55.75) (60.25, 64.25, 68.25)" / 81 (90.5, 101, 110.5) (120.5, 130, 139.5) (151, 160.5, 170.5) cm at full bust.

The front of the garment measures 0.25 (0.25, 1.25, 2.25) (2.25, 3.25, 3.75) (5.25, 5.25, 6.25)" / 0.5 (1.5, 2.5, 5) (5.5, 8.5, 9.5) (12.5, 13.5, 15.5) cm wider than the back. Optional bust darts are available, but may require additional yarn and buttons to complete. See "Bust Darts (Appendix)" on page 10 for more information.

The designer is wearing Size B Cropped (the purple-gray sample) and Size C full length (the white sample). She has the following circumference body measurements: 32" / 82 cm upper bust, 34" / 86.5 full bust, and 10.75" / 27.5 cm upper arm.

Gauge

22 sts x 28 rows = $4 \times 4'' / 10$ cm knit flat in Stockinette stitch with Needle A and 2x2 rib with Needle B

Materials & Tools

Yarn Selection & Pattern Views

Choose a DK weight yarn that achieves gauge. I have selected two very different wool-based yarns to show this pattern.

One is a woolen-spun yarn, for the longer, A-line shaped version, and one is a worsted-spun 90% Merino, 10% silk with more bounce and a different drape for the cropped version.

VIEW A

Features a cropped body and no body shaping. Hem lands between waist and high hip.

Shown in <u>De Rerum Natura's Pénélope</u> (90% organic Merinos d'Arles and 10% mulberry silk, 145 yards / 133 meters / 50 g / 1.75 oz), shown in the colorway Bois Flotté.

620 (710, 790, 860) (940, 1020, 1080) (1170, 1270, 1360) yards / 570 (650, 720, 790) (860, 930, 990) (1070, 1160, 1240) meters

OR 5 (5, 6, 6) (7, 8, 8) (9, 9, 10) balls of De Rerum Natura's *Pénélope*

OR 3 (3, 4, 4) (4, 5, 5) (5, 6, 6) hanks of Harrisville Designs' *daylights*

VIEW B

Features a full-length body and gentle A-line shaping in the body. Hem lands at high hip.

Shown in <u>Harrisville Designs' daylights</u> (100% American Cormo & Wool, 250 yards / 229 meters / 100 g / 3.5 oz), shown in the colorway Lint.

880 (980, 1100, 1210) (1320, 1410, 1510) (1640, 1770, 1840) yards / 800 (900, 1010, 1110) (1210, 1290, 1380) (1500, 1620, 1680) meters

OR 7 (7, 8, 9) (10, 10, 11) (12, 13, 13) balls of De Rerum Natura's *Pénélope*

OR 4 (4, 5, 5) (6, 6, 7) (7, 8, 8) hanks of Harrisville Designs' *daylights*

FOR BUST DARTS

20 (25, 30, 30) (35, 40, 45) (45, 50, 55) yards / meters for every 1" / 2.5 cm of bust darts.

Needles

A (Main Fabric): US 6 / 4.0 mm circular needles in 32" / 80 cm length or longer for larger sizes to match body length.

B (Ribbing): US 5 / 3.75 mm circular needles in 32" / 80 cm or longer, plus needles for working small circumferences in the round (ie. magic loop or DPN's)

Spare circular needles US 6 / 4.0 mm or smaller.

Notions

Waste yarn or stitch holders, tapestry needle, a thinner needle for sewing buttons, and <u>0.9" / 23 mm buttons</u> in the following amounts:


- View A: 4 buttons
- View B: 7 buttons
- Bust darts: An additional button for every 2" / 5 cm added.


More or fewer buttons may be used if desired to achieve different spacing.

Construction Notes

- This pattern is worked bottom up in one piece, then split for fronts and back. Armholes and v-neck are worked at the same time, but written directly (without at the same time instructions) for ease of use.
- The shoulders are joined with Three-Needle Bind Off (see Special Techniques). After wet blocking, the neckband is picked up and worked with button holes, and the armholes picked up and worked, all in rib.
