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SEASHORE CAMI

The Seashore Cami is half of a summer twinset. Knit and wear it on its own or with the Seashore Jacket. Either way, you'll enjoy long walks in nature, on the beach, or otherwise. Breezy diamond eyelet panes decorate this delicate spaghetti strap piece.

This cami's perfectly proportioned armhole and neck shaping give good bra coverage and is easy to wear and style. It features a rounded v-neck in the front, and a higher v-neck in the back.

Once finished, you'll have a sophisticated piece to wear casually as loungewear, or dressed up for going out and about.

Size Selection

Sizes A (B, C, D) (E, F, G) (H, I, J) to fit actual upper bust measurements of 31 (34.25, 37.5, 40.75) (44, 47.25, 50.5) (53.75, 57, 60.25)" / 77.5 (85.5, 94, 102) (110, 118, 126.5) (134.5, 142.5, 150.5) cm.

It was graded for full bust measurements of 30 (34, 38, 42) (46, 50, 54) (58, 62, 66)" / 76 (86.5, 96.5, 106.5) (117, 127, 137) (147.5, 157.5, 167.5) cm.

Finished garment circumferences are:

Straight View - 28.25 (32.25, 36.25, 40) (43.75, 47.5, 51) (54.25, 58, 61.25)" / 70.5 (80.5, 90.5, 100) (109.5, 118.5, 127.5) (135.5, 145, 153.5) cm;

Curvy View - 29.25 (33.5, 37.25, 41.5) (45.25, 49, 52.75) (56.25, 60.25, 64)" / 73.5 (83.5, 93.5, 103.5) (113.5, 122, 132) (140.5, 150.5, 160) cm

Choose a size based on upper bust measurements ([read more at our blog](#)).

This pattern was graded with an intended negative ease of 1.75 (1.75, 1.75, 2) (2.25, 2.5, 3) (3.75, 4, 4.75)" / 4.5 (4.5, 4.5, 5) (5.5, 6.5, 7.5) (9.5, 10, 12) cm. Choose the curvy version if your full bust measurement is larger than the one given here for your upper bust size.

The designer is wearing Size B. Their measurements: 33" / 84 upper bust and 34" / 86.5 cm full bust, with 11" / 28 cm upper arm.

Mia is wearing Size D with 2" / 5 cm darts in the curvy view. Her measurements: 38" / 96.5 cm and 44" / 112 cm full bust.

Gauge

27 sts and 38 rows = 4 x 4" / 10 x 10 cm, knit in pattern flat and in the round with Needle A

How to Swatch

To swatch for this pattern, cast on 52 sts plus any border sts desired, then work the following:

Edge sts, *k4, p1, Pointelle Lace 1, p1, k4, p1, Pointelle Lace 2, p1; repeat from * once more, edge stitches.

Work at least 4 repeats of the charts to complete swatch.

Pattern Support

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Materials & Tools

Yarn Selection

Choose a fingering weight yarn. This pattern is flexible to any amount of included wool or cellulose/plant fibers.

White sample features Aimee Sher Makes' in house [Comfort Silk Linen](#) (400 yards / 365 meters / 3.5 oz / 100 grams, 50% Merino + 25% Mulberry Silk + 25% Linen) in the colorway "Milk Tea."

Pink sample features Knitting For Olive's [Pure Silk](#) (273 yards / 250 meters / 1.75 oz / 50 grams, 100% Bourette Silk) in the colorway "Rhubarb Juice."

Yardage

CURVY VIEW

2 (2, 2, 2) (3, 3, 3) (3, 3, 3) hanks of Comfort Silk Linen, or 490 (600, 670, 740) (810, 890, 950) (1010, 1100, 1160) yards / 500 (610, 680, 760) (830, 910, 980) (1040, 1140, 1210) meters

STRAIGHT VIEW

2 (2, 2, 2) (3, 3, 3) (3, 3, 4) hanks of Comfort Silk Linen, or 470 (580, 650, 720) (790, 860, 920) (990, 1080, 1140) yards / 430 (540, 600, 660) (730, 790, 850) (910, 990, 1050) meters

BUST DARTS

Add 15 (15, 15, 20) (20, 25, 25) (25, 30, 30) yards/ meters per cup size added.

TWIN SET YARDAGE

To knit the entire twin set, you'll need 4 (5, 5, 5) (6, 6, 7) (7, 8, 8) hanks of Comfort Silk Linen plus extra for bust darts for both, if using bust darts.

Needles

A (Main Fabric): US2.5 / 3.0 mm in a long circular, 32" / 80 cm or longer, to match body circumference being worked, and DPNs.

B (Ribbing): US1 / 2.5 mm in a long circular, 32" / 80 cm or longer, to match body circumference being worked.

Notions

Stitch markers, smooth waste yarn, tapestry needle.

Construction Notes

- This pattern is knit bottom up in one piece, separated for front and back, and then joined again with Three Needle Bind-Off. Then, it's finished with polished I-cord edges along the armhole and neckline.
- Optional bust darts come in 4 sizes to add 1-5" / 2.5-12.5 cm vertically. Due to the stitch pattern repeat, these do not come in the regular 1" / 2.5 cm increments of other Aimee Sher patterns, so select your size carefully (see Page 11).
- This is a close-fitting, cropped garment. If you are lengthening, you will need to add width to the front and back to accommodate hips. I recommend the underarm area where there is already a Stockinette panel.

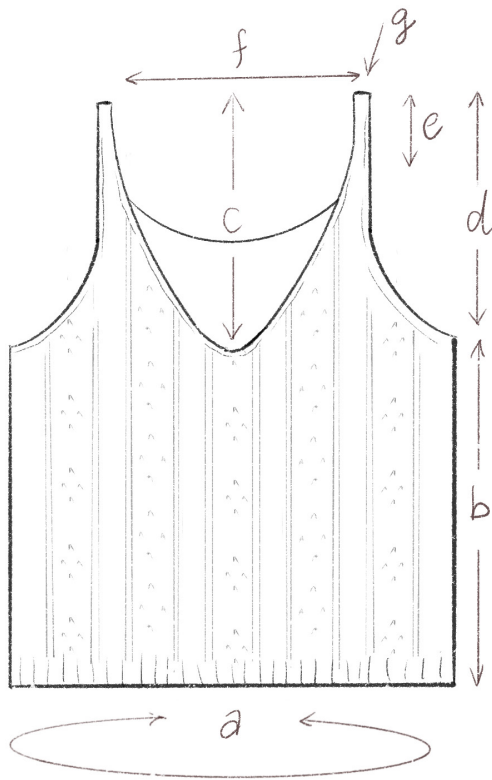

Abbreviations

BOR	beginning of round

Schematics

A, Chest circumference - straight: 28.25 (32.25, 36.25, 40) (43.75, 47.5, 51) (54.25, 58, 61.25)" / 70.5 (80.5, 90.5, 100) (109.5, 118.5, 127.5) (135.5, 145, 153.5) cm; curvy: 29.25 (33.5, 37.25, 41.5) (45.25, 49, 52.75) (56.25, 60.25, 64)" / 73.5 (83.5, 93.5, 103.5) (113.5, 122, 132) (140.5, 150.5, 160) cm

B, Body length - 10.25 (11.75, 11.75, 11.75) (11.75, 12, 12) (12, 12.25, 12.25)" / 26 (30, 30, 30) (30, 30.5, 30.5) (30.5, 31, 31) cm

C, V-neck length - 7.75 (7.75, 8, 8.25) (8.25, 8.5, 8.75) (8.75, 9, 9.5)" / 19.5 (19.5, 20, 20.5) (20.5, 21, 21.5) (22, 22.5, 23.5) cm

D, Armhole length - 7 (7, 7.5, 7.5) (8, 8.25, 8.75) (9, 9.25, 9.5)" / 17.5 (17.5, 18.5, 19) (20.5, 21, 22) (22.5, 24, 24.5) cm

E, Strap length - 2.5 (2.5, 2.75, 2.75) (3.25, 3.25, 3.25) (3.25, 3.25, 3.5)" / 6.5 (6.5, 7, 7) (8.5, 8.5, 8.5) (8.5, 8.5, 9) cm

F, Back neck width - 7.5 (7.5, 7.75, 8.5) (8.75, 9, 9) (9.25, 9.75, 10)" / 19 (19, 19.5, 21) (22, 22.5, 22.5) (23.5, 24, 25) cm

G, Strap width (before finishing) - 0.5 (0.5, 0.5, 0.75) (0.75, 0.75, 0.75) (1, 1, 1)" / 1.5 (1.5, 1.5, 2) (2, 2, 2) (2, 2, 2) cm

Modifications

For a full hip adjustment, cast on for the next size up, and add those stitches evenly in the knit even parts in the set up around the side marker. You can perform A-line decreases throughout the body (4 in each decrease round) to achieve the full bust circumference for your size.
